## **Friends of the Arlington Boys & Girls Club –**

Next summer the Club will undergo a major facility upgrade as we remodel the girls' locker room, add a family changing area, and expand program space for youth members. We pride ourselves on providing a safe, clean facility and do not defer necessary maintenance projects. The complete gutting and refit of this area of the building will cost approximately \$400,000.

In 2012 we will celebrate the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Club and the 50<sup>th</sup> year in this building. In the mid-seventies, when Boys Clubs became Boys & Girls Clubs, the building was redesigned to better serve female members. The old boys' locker room was converted to the girls' locker room – using much of the original tile and appliances. While many community buildings of the same vintage are being razed and rebuilt, our rigorous maintenance program has helped us to avoid this extremely costly option. Adhering to this program will ensure that the current Clubhouse will serve our membership for many years to come.

While we are grateful to the myriad donors who support the Club on a regular basis, this new undertaking requires gifts large and small from varied sources.
